

## Week 11 (1<sup>st</sup> Qtr) Study Questions

1. Moses reminds the Israelites that God is committed to 2 basic things. What were these? He reminds that if they obey him, their wealth will be multiplied, but they must do what? Also, he tells them that when they cross the Jordan and take the cities that God delivers unto them, it will not be because of their own righteousness, but because of what and what does he remind them of because of this?
2. Moses tells the Israelites about the blessings they will receive if they do what? Also, he reminds them that if they obey God, then what? Moses also reminds them that if a prophet rises up amongst them and tries to lead them to other gods, they are to do what with that prophet? He also reminds them about servants and what do with them in the 7<sup>th</sup> year, what is that?
3. Moses goes over the clean and unclean animals again, and makes a long list, what were the criteria for clean animals for them to eat and the animals of the sea? He also reminds them of all the feasts to observe and what were they to do about debts owed every 7 years?
4. Moses says a false worshipper shall be put to death, but what does scripture say about the number of witnesses that have to be to accuse him? How are the Israelites to settle disputes? What are they to do when they take over a new land or city? What were the cities of refuge? What is the example Moses uses for the need for a city of refuge?
5. If a son is rebellious and the parents can do nothing with him, what do they have the right to do? If a man marries a wife but does not love her and marries another and loves her more, but the unloved wife has a son who is firstborn, what does Moses say about his portion of the inheritance? What are they to do if they find their neighbor's donkey going astray? What does Moses have to say about cross dressing? What happens if a man lies with a virgin unmarried?
6. Can an illegitimate child and descendants enter the assembly of God? What about an Ammonite or a Moabite? If not, why not? If a woman's husband died before she had a son, who was to become of her husband? Also, if she then had a son, who's name would he take? After a man married, how long was his honeymoon and he had an exemption from war and business?

7. What were some of the blessings and curses that Moses give to the Israelites? What does God tell them will happen to them if they do not obey him? In Deut. 28, verses 64-68, what does God say will happen if they do not obey? Knowing what we know now of history, did the Israelites heed this warning? If not, did this happen to the Isrealites?

Stretch:

1. In Deuteronomy 18:15 Moses says “The Lord your God will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your midst, From your brethren, Him you shall hear.” Who is Moses talking about in this verse and verses 16-18 of this chapter in Deuteronomy? Hint: Take a look at Acts chapter 3 and Acts chapter 7.
