

Week 3 (1st Qtr) Study Questions

1. What is Elihu and what does he have to say to Job? What does he have to say to the three friends of Job? What does Elihu have to say about God?
2. When God finally speaks, what does he say to Job? What is Job's response to God? Who wins the battle between God and Job?
3. Name 3 main themes that run through the Book of Job. Each having to do with the providence of God and his relationship with his creation.
4. Who is Abram and where did he live? What is commanded of him by God? What was the big lie that Abraham told in Egypt? What happened because of it? What choice does Abram give to Lot? What promise does God give to Abram in Gen. 13. ?
5. Why was Abram considered righteous by God? What does God reveal to Abram in a dream or vision? What does Sarai give to Abram and why? How does Sarai deal with Hagar? What is the name of Hagar's child and what promise is made about him?
6. What does God change Abram's name to and what does he command Abram and his descendants to do as a sign of the covenant between God and Abram and his descendants? What does God say will happen to Sarah? How does Abram respond to this?
7. What does Sarah do when she is told that she will have a child at her old age? What does God decide to do with Sodom and Gomorrah? What happens to the angels that he sends to Sodom? What do they tell Lot and his wife and 2 daughters to do? What happens to Lot's wife? What do Lot's 2 daughters do after the 2 of the them and Lot settle in a cave in the mountains outside of Zoar
8. Abraham makes another journey to the land of Gerar and what does he ask Sarah to say to the king of Gerar? Who was the king of Gerar? What does God say to the king because of this? Was Sarah Abraham's daughter as well as his wife?
9. What is the name give to the child that is borne to Sarah in her old age? How old is the child when he is circumcised and why do you think he had to be that old before he could be circumcised?

10. God decides to test Abraham's faith by asking him to do what? Does Abraham obey God's command? Does God stop Abraham and if so, what does he do if anything? God again tells Abraham what will happen to all the nations of the Earth because he has obeyed him?

Stretch Question:

1. Who were the Behemoth and the Leviathan that are described in Job Chapters 40 and 41? Also, who was a contemporary to Job in biblical history?
2. Other than the covenant that God made with Abraham, what attribute of Abraham is written about several times over in the New Testament?
