

Week 5 (1st Qtr) Study Questions

1. In Exodus, how does the new Pharaoh describe the nation of Israel? What does he do because of this? Exodus describes the birth of Moses. Who was his mother and father and what did his mother do with him when he was 3 months old and why? Who is Moses's sister and what does she do at the river?
2. Where does Moses end up being raised and by whom? After Moses is grown, what does he do to an Egyptian that he sees beating a Hebrew? Where does he go after he realizes this has become known? Who does he meet in this place? While Moses is tending the flock of Jethro (his Father-in-law), who appears to him and how do they appear to him? Who speaks to Moses after this? What is asked of Moses and how does he respond to this? What signs are given to Moses to prove he is from God? Who does God ask Moses to take with him to Egypt?
3. When Moses and Aaron go in to meet with Pharaoh what do they ask of him? How does Pharaoh respond and what signs are shown to him? How does Pharaoh react to this? What happens to the Hebrews because of this and how do they respond to Moses and Aaron?
4. God tells Moses and Aaron to back in to Pharaoh and do what? What do Moses and Aaron tell Pharaoh? How does Pharaoh respond? What does God tell Moses to do next? Name the first 9 plagues that God brings on Egypt and describe how Pharaoh reacts to each one? At which plagues does God differentiate between the Hebrews and the Egyptians and why does he do this?
5. After the 9th plague, what instructions does God give to Moses? Describe what plague is to be the last one and tell what the Hebrews are supposed to do to get ready for the last plague? How does Pharaoh respond to the last plague? What feast is instituted for the Hebrews to remember each year because of this event?
6. After the Hebrews escape, the Egyptians pursue them, what great event occurs to save the Hebrews from the Egyptians at this time? What does God use to show he is traveling with the Hebrews at this time? Hint: Something by day and something by night.

7. What do Moses and the Hebrews do after they are saved? (i.e. Exodus 15)
Where do they journey to next? What do the whole congregation do to Moses and Aaron next and why? How does God respond to this and what does he do at this time? In Exodus 17, what is the next thing that the Hebrews ask of Moses and what does God tell Moses to do to relieve them?
8. Who comes to fight with the Israelites in the desert and what does Moses have to do so the Israelites will win the battle? Who comes to visit Moses after this and what does he tell Moses he needs to do to keep from wearing himself out?
9. In Exodus 19, where do the Israelites camp what does God tell Moses to do there? What does God give to Moses at this time and where does he do it?

Stretch Question:

1. What event in Exodus is compared to Baptism by the apostle Paul. Explain how this comparison can be made. Hint: Read 1 Corinthians 10.
