

Week 7 (1st Qtr) Study Questions

1. What did God allow the Hebrews to do to cover their unintentional sins? What would the Priests do for the entire congregation? What would they do for a ruler who sinned? What about the common people? What was a grain offering?
2. What had to be done to cover a robbery or extortion? In Lev. 7, what things does God tell Moses that the people are not to eat? Why did God tell them they could not eat of these things? In Lev. 11, God gives the commands as far as what animals could be eaten, what are they?
3. Whom did God consecrate as the Priesthood of the Hebrews? How did Moses make the people aware of this? So, from what tribe did the Priesthood come from? In Lev. 9, what consumed the offering from Aaron and the people. Who offered a profane fire to the Lord and what happened to them? Could the Priests carry any wine or drink into the tabernacle?
4. After childbirth, how long was a woman to be considered unclean? How long did it take before she was purified and could return to the sanctuary? What did a man or woman have to do if they had a sore and what would be done to them if the sore spreads over their body? What was the scapegoat?
5. In Lev. 18, God gives a list of the next of kin that each man or woman was not to marry or have relations with. How far out on a person's family tree did a person have to go before it was ok to marry? Also, in verse 22 and following, God lists certain things that are abominations, what were these?
6. Once the Hebrews came into Canaan and had planted trees and gardens, how many years were they to wait before eating of the fruit of it? What did God have to say about people who practiced soothsaying or sorcery or divination?
7. If a Priest married, could he marry a harlot or a widow? Why or why not? List the feasts that the Hebrews were to observe and what months and days of each year were they to be observed.
8. What was the consequence of a person who blasphemed the name of the Lord? A murderer? A man who kills another man's animal? A man who causes disfigurement to a neighbor?

9. In addition the command to observe the Sabbath, God also commanded the Hebrews to observe a Sabbath year, what was this and why did he ask them to do this? What would occur during the Sabbath year? Also, God commanded that they observe a Jubilee Year. When did this occur and what was to occur during the Jubilee year?

10. What does God have to say about idol worship? What is written about the value of a slave and exchange rates and so forth?

Stretch:

1. God commanded that each male baby be circumcised on the 8th day of their lives. Why was *this specific day* selected and why did God command that the Hebrews were to only eat of certain foods and to make sure they were purified after childbirth and so forth?
