3.	Peter is referring to the day	(2 Peter 3:10b; Revelation 21:1; John 6:39, 40, 44, 54).
4.	Peter is referring to the	day (2 Peter 3:10; Matthew 24:1-3, 36-39).

1.	We should live with	(2 Peter 3:14; 1 Corinthians 1:4-8; 2 Corinthians 5:2, 4).
2.	We should seek	(2 Peter 3:14; Genesis 2:23-24; Isaiah 59:2; Romans 5:1, 10; 1 Peter 3:21).
3.	We should be	_ (2 Peter 3:14, 17; Matthew 24:42-44).
4.	We should never stop	(2 Peter 3:18; Revelation 3:15-16, 19).
