







## Youth Bible Class Expectations and Guidelines For Buford Kids & Pre-teens (Babies to 6th Grade)

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Screening</b></p> 	<p>A screener will administer a temperature check and ask standard health screening questions of parents for children in Cradle Roll or Annex 2 classes. Screeners will ask older children directly.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Screening Stations</b></p>  <p style="font-size: small; text-align: center;">Youth Bible Class <b>SCREENING STATION</b> Temperature Check &amp; Questions</p>	<p>Stations will be positioned in the classroom for the smallest children and at the upper and lower entrances to the classrooms of Annex 2 such that they will not obstruct stairwells. Please use the appropriate location based upon the classroom location of your child.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cradle Roll: Go directly to the classroom in Annex 1</li> <li>• 18mo-3rd Grade: Annex 2 lower classroom hallway main lobby entrance past the stairwell</li> <li>• 4th - 6th Grades: Annex 2 hallway upper entrance past the stairwell</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Drop-Off &amp; Pickup</b></p> 	<p>Screening will cause some congestion as children enter and leave. Teaching assistants will walk the child between the station and the classroom for 18mo through preschool. There will be <u>3 bells</u> for specific groups to pickup youth from class. Parents please be ready to pick up small children at the appropriate bell.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cradle Roll Class: Please pickup at the third/last bell</li> <li>• 18mo-2yr Class: Please pickup at the first bell</li> <li>• Preschool Class: Please pickup at the second bell about 5 minutes after the first bell</li> <li>• K and Up Classes: They will be dismissed at the third/last bell and will meet you at your designated location in the main lobby or auditorium</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>In Class Masking</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ages 2yrs and Less: Face coverings are strongly discouraged for these children</li> <li>• Preschool and Older: Face coverings may be worn during class but are not required</li> <li>• Teachers: Face coverings may be worn during class but are not required</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Class Transition Masking</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ages 2 and younger: Face coverings are strongly discouraged for these children.</li> <li>• Ages 3 thru 9: Children in this age group may wear face coverings at the discretion of their guardians while going through the building.</li> <li>• Ages 10 years and older: It is recommended to wear face coverings while going through the building.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>In the Classroom</b></p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cleaning/sanitizing surfaces and manipulatives will be protocol</li> <li>• Dedicated EDU supplies are provided to limit sharing with others using the space</li> <li>• Physical distancing will be applied where possible in the classroom</li> </ul>
