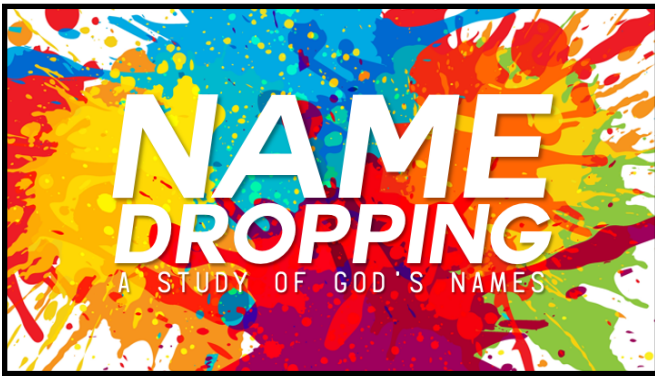




YAHWEH ROHI
