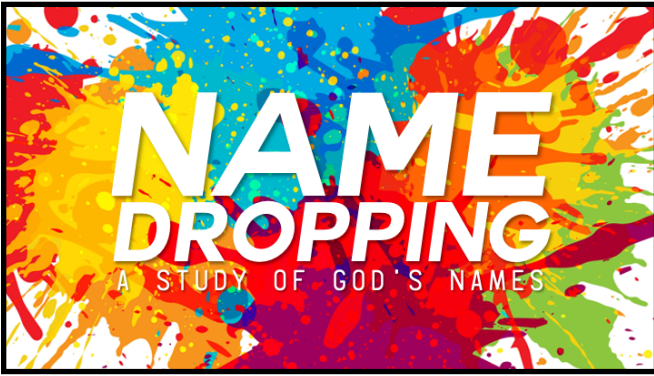




YAHWEH TSIDKENU

JEREMIAH 23:5-6

One of the ways, if not the primary way, that God has made Himself known to us is through His names. Throughout the Bible, God drops different names in different situations to reveal different aspects of His character and His will. So, if we want to know God, then we have start by getting to know His names.

The name that is translated “The LORD is our _____” in Jeremiah 23:6 and 33:16 is Yahweh Tsidkenu. And this name communicates God's role as our _____.

Righteousness is “a desire to see God’s standards _____ and _____ in every area of life” (Deuteronomy 6:5, 6, 8, 24-25).¹ That’s why Jesus identified righteousness as something we’re to “_____ and _____ for” in the Beatitudes (Matthew 5:6), and why He instructed us in the Sermon on the Mount to “_____ first his kingdom and his righteousness” (Matthew 6:33).

1. YAHWEH TSIDKENU IMPLIES THAT RIGHTEOUSNESS IS _____ TO GOD.

3. YAHWEH TSIDKENU IMPLIES THAT RIGHTEOUSNESS MUST BE _____ TO US FROM GOD.

We have a dilemma because the Bible makes it clear that “the _____ will not inherit the kingdom of God” (1 Corinthians 6:9; cf. Matthew 25:31-46).

But the Bible also says that God “made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the _____ of God” (2 Corinthians 5:21)
