LAMENTATIONS 3:22-24

All throughout the New Testament, God is identified as “faithful” (1 Corinthians 1:9; 10:13; 1 Thessalonians 5:24; 2 Thessalonians 3:3; 2 Timothy 2:13; Hebrews 10:23; 1 John 1:9). Since God is the standard of faithfulness, we must look to His example of it in order to determine what it entails, and the best example of God’s faithfulness is found in Hosea.
